If you would like to remain **anonymous** please mention that and your comments will be kept private. Also we are going to be working to bring parties from Wyoming, YNP, FS, and our own County together to hold at least one public meeting here in Cooke City. There have been discussions on this topic already, which have not included our community, whom it affects the most. These other parties will not be looking at our **3 major issues that the Chamber is concerned with**, these issues have to be resolved **BEFORE** they plow; 1) Parking 2) Trail Access 3) Plowing.

Road Opening Schedule:

- **April 16, 2010**—Weather permitting, west-side roads open to motor vehicles. Mammoth to Norris Junction to Madison Junction to Old Faithful; Madison Junction to West Entrance. In addition, Norris Junction to Canyon opens to wheeled vehicles.
- **May 7, 2010**—Weather permitting, Canyon to Lake, Lake to East Entrance opens to wheeled vehicles.
- **May 14, 2010**—Tower to Tower Fall opens to wheeled vehicles. Lake to West Thumb, West Thumb to Old Faithful, and South to Old Faithful opens to wheeled vehicles. Cooke City via Colter Pass to the Chief Joseph Scenic Highway intersection to the Long Lake gate shall open as soon thereafter as possible.
- **May 28, 2010**—Long Lake Gate over the Beartooth, and Tower Falls to Canyon will be open.
