Woody Creek was named after Tazwell Woody who was a hunting guide to Teddy Roosevelt.

Wolverine Creek was named by Bart Henderson, Horn Miller, Ed Hibbard & James Gourley on their prospecting trip. "It was the first wolverine any of us had ever seen and consequently gave the same name to the creek". They shot the wolverine.

The Switch Back Bar owned by Vincelette's Silver Gate Lodge and Log Cabin Camp is now known as the Grizzly Lodge.
