Ladies and Gentlemen get your favorite cookie recipe and enter the Cooke City Golden Cookie Caper Contest at our Fifth Traditional Cooke City Celebration on Aug. 1 & 2! No fee for entries.

Advanced entry registration: You may fill out your entry form at the Cooke City Chamber between July 1 and July 28, 2008. You will be asked to nickname your cookie in honor of one of the "historical mines" in our area. You must also submit a copy of your recipe with your entry form.

Presentation of Cookie Entry: Your entry of two dozen cookies is due at the "Historic Antler Inn" between 9 and 10 am on Friday, August 1, 2008. Cookie entries must be placed on an aluminum-covered cardboard and slipped into a heavy-duty gallon plastic bag. Judging will begin at 10:30 am. Contestants may not be present during judging.

Judging Criteria/Rules: Judging will be based on: Appearance, Texture & Taste. Cake-like or bar-style cookies will be accepted. [NOTE: NO cream based filling or toppers will be accepted in the contest. No puff pastry will be accepted.] Frostings, glazes, toppers, nuts, candies and/or dried fruits will be the contestant's choice. Any shapes, cutouts or drop-style designs will also be the contestant's decision.

Only one champion will be chosen!

The winner will be announced at the Saturday night Cooke City celebration.
